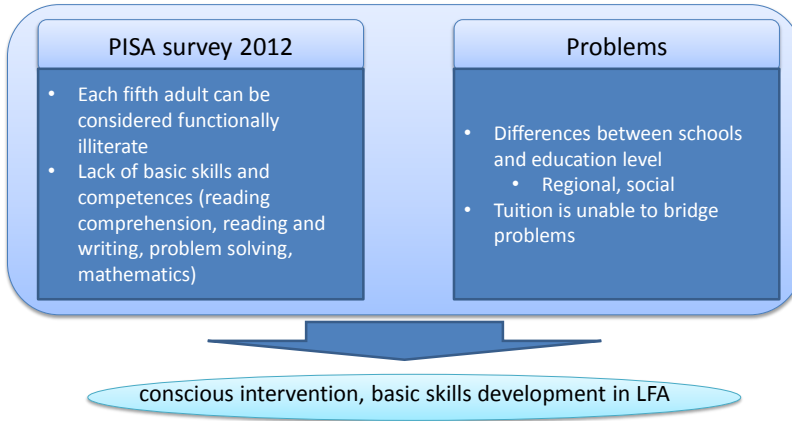
Situation in Hungary

- People with low skills rate was 25.7% in Hungary
- In the lack of professional qualification people cannot be involved in employment



- One of the most pressing problem regarding economic and social problems is employment shortage

40 000	adults involved in basic skill development training



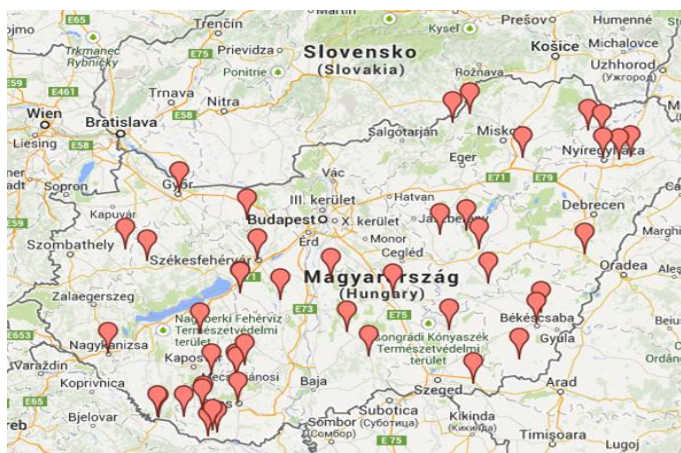


Institute objectives
