Communities of practice

- · Open to join
- Currently we have six communities
- Two EBSN communities:
 - Creation and Implementation of National Policy for Basic Skills Provision
 - Workplace literacy



Collaborative spaces

- Can be joined upon invitation
- Private spaces for people working in partnerships



Partner Search tool

- Allows people to find partners for their adult learning projects
- · Currently undergoing usability refinements
 - 350 registered organisations
 - 183 partner request
 - Over 90,000 page views



New subthemes

- 5 main thematic areas
- 22 subthemes
- 2 new subthemes coming up
 - E-learning
 - Financial literacy



Nordic portal

- Better accommodate non-EU languages
- Area with content collated from EPALE's Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden)
