VET qualifications

- The same structure in all VET qualifications (EQF 1-4);
- Made by Centres of Expertise (or knowledge) on VET and Labour Market
 - Different branches of industry;
 - Example: innovam (about: cars and bicycles).





ROC's

- Regional Education and Training Centres (roc's):
 - develop courses based on the qualifications;
 - are responsible for examination of the qualification, mostly with capability tests.

 - Desired result;
 - Competency:
 - Components;
 - Performance indicator (important tests);
 - Knowledge and skills (important courses).
